References may be submitted online as well, but we request that a written copy on institutional letterhead be sent.

The AAUW-Walla Walla Branch NCCWSL scholarship will pay selected student's conference registration which includes your lodging and five meals. Travel cost and extra lodging fees, due to the distance and time change, are also covered. You will likely need to travel on June 1st. You may also want to attend one or more of the special sessions being offered that are not covered by the registration. See the **NCCWSL** website for details.

Upon your return, please submit to AAUW-Walla Walla Branch a written report of the conference, sharing your experiences and lessons learned from attending NCCWSL. Send the report to Jenny Romine. We will also ask you to present your report at an AAUW branch meeting at a time that will work with your schedule.
